

Identification (ID) Requirements

- The first and last name that the candidate uses to register must match exactly the first and last name on both IDs that are presented on test day.
- All IDs required must be issued by the country in which the candidate is testing. If the candidate does not have the qualifying Primary ID issued from the country they are testing in, a passport from the country of citizenship is required.
- Candidate is required to present two forms of *original* (no photo copies), *valid* (unexpired) ID. One primary (name, photo, and signature) and one secondary (with name and signature).

Exceptions:

- Expired forms of identification are not acceptable; unless accompanied by valid renewal papers.
- Any government issued ID missing a visible signature or that has an embedded signature, can be supplemented with an original (no photo copies), valid (unexpired) ID that has at least a name and signature. **Please note that this is for government Issued IDs only. Other acceptable ID types must have a visible signature and can not be supplemented.*
- Any candidate exceptions to the ID policy must be pre-approved by the Pearson VUE customer service center at least three business days before the scheduled exam appointment.
